**Class 2**            **Retrained Racehorse – Judge: Mr John Edwards**  
For horses that are registered with Wetherby's and  
have previously raced

**Classes 3, 4 & 6 – Judge: Mrs Ann Bassett**

**Class 3**            **Open Riding Horse**  
Judged on type, ride and confirmation

**Class 4**            **Local hunter**  
Open to Horses that reside within 15 miles of the  
showground or who are owned by Subscribers of the  
Devon and Somerset Staghounds. Stags head to the  
highest placed paid-up subscriber

**Class 5**            **Competition Pony - Judge: Ms Gill Wright**  
Open to Horses 15hh and under, ridden

**Class 6**            **Open Hunter**

**Working Hunter**  
Open to horses over 15hh  
Fences not to exceed 90cm height

**Class 8**            **Working Hunter**  
For Horses under 15hh – Fences not to exceed 75cm

- Class 19**      Nursery Stakes, 30cm, must be led  
**Class 20**      Nursery Stakes, 30cm, assisted but not led  
**Class 21**      Nursery Stakes 40cm Show Jumping – Can be led / assisted  
*There will be a special rosette for the most stylish round in classes 19-21*

**Class 22**      **Ride & Run 40cm max. 12 years & under**  
Rider must jump the course and a different person must run the course

**Class 23**      **50cm Show Jumping** – Can be assisted  
**Class 24**      **60cm Pairs**

**Class 25**      **Ride & Run Max 60cm Open Jumping**  
Rider must jump the course and a different person must run the course

**Class 26**      **Show Jumping 70cm**  
**Class 27**      **Show Jumping 80cm**  
**Class 28**      **Show Jumping 90cm**

All clear rounds will jump again against the clock
